1. Competition rules.
2. Fruit, vegetables *and* flower classes are open to any individual or group not being employed as a gardener or employing a gardener.
3. Classes in other sections are open to anyone not being a professional in the art or craft of that section.
4. This schedule is designed to include a mix of categories and classes to encourage people of all ages and skill levels to enter. It is a fun competition.....
5. The entrance fee for each entry is 50p. Or £6 to enter as many classes as you wish. **Payment of £6 grants an exhibitor pass (given when items are staged). You will get free entry to the show. CHILDRENS classes are free. Age must be stated on entry form.**
6. Every lot for exhibition must be entered prior to the show. Completed entry forms may be forwarded with the fee in a sealed envelope to Dhinsa News, Market Place Wragby. No later than the Friday before the show at 3pm. Or to (by post or by hand) The Secretary, 6 Scothern Lane Langworth Lincoln or email the classes you wish to enter on jrbug18@icloud.com before Friday at 7pm. Entries may be telephoned Thursday before the show between 7-9pm. 01522-750169.
7. A competitor may enter any number of classes. To a maximum of 2 items in each class.
8. All vegetables are to be entered clean. Every item exhibited must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor. Being grown/ made / produced by them.
9. Prizes may be withheld at the judges discretion. The judges decision is final.
10. Pot plants must have been owned for at least 3 months. Photos, crafts should have been taken /made in the last 2 years.
11. All exhibits must be staged by 9-30 on show day. And should remain on display until after presentation of prizes at 4 pm. Prize money will be given between 4-15 and 4-30. First place wins £2 and prize card. 2nd place gets £1 and prize card. Children's classes win rosettes, special prizes.
12. All rules of the main show will apply.
13. Exhibitors cars may be brought onto the show filed for dropping off only. Then parked in the official car park.
14. All perpetual trophies must be returned before end of July. 2018

Presentation of trophies will take place in the Horticulture Tent at 4pm followed by an auction of any produce donated by exhibitors at 4.30pm.
